The last Saturday of April, the 26th from 9:00 a.m. to noon has been designated as spring clean up day for the park at 450 South and 250 West.



Volunteers are always welcome to help shovel and spread mulch, clean up winter dead fall of limbs, and pick up litter. No advance notice needed. Just show up.

The **new pond** should be in fishing condition this spring. Last fall it was stocked with feeder fish: Bluegill, Readear Sunfish, and Fathead Minnows. Some time this spring the Aquatic Control Company

will return to stock with Small Mouth Bass.



The Indiana Department of Natural Resources requires a fishing license to fish in the pond. Visit their website at https://www.gooutdoorsin.com/login to find out the rules and costs of various licenses.

Look for an update on the Shadeland Facebook page when the bass will be stocked.

The Parks Committee meets at 6:30 p.m. the third Tuesday each month at the Town Hall. Members of the public

are welcome to attend.



Over the winter the committee has been discussing topics like installing a walking path around the pond, benches along the path, the placement of a memorial sign for the Molter family who donated the land for the pond.

ers is needed. It's easy. Please scan this UPC code with your smart phone camera. It will prompt to open a link to YouTube




